Task 1-A: Read the text and answer the questions. (2 points)

The Tiger

The tiger, a member of the cat family, is one of the most endangered animals in the world. There are probably no more than 8000 left in the wild. Each tiger has more than 100 stripes, which are just like human fingerprints because they are completely different for each tiger. Male tigers are usually bigger than females. They live in Asia and in many different climates. There are five main sub-species of tiger in the world. Another three species became extinct in the last century.

- **The Bengal Tiger** lives in India, Nepal and Bangladesh and only about 3000 are still in the wild today. About 333 live in zoos. The male tiger usually weighs between 180 and 230 kilos and is 2.5 metres long. All white tigers are male Bengal tigers. They don't have the usual orange colouring but are mainly white with blue eyes and sometimes brown or black stripes or no stripes at all.
- **The Indochinese Tiger** lives in Thailand and South China and some parts of Malaysia. They weigh about 180 kilos and are about 2.75 metres long. There are only between 1200 and 1800 in the wild with sixty in zoos. They are darker than the Bengal tiger, but lighter than the Sumatran tigers. They have short black narrow stripes and large white markings on the stomach, throat and cheeks.
- **The Siberian Tiger** lives in Russia and is the largest of all the tigers. It can be 3.5m long and weigh up to 280 kilos. There are only about 400 in the wild and about 490 in captivity.
- **The Sumatran Tiger** only lives on the Indonesian island of Sumatra and is the smallest of the tigers. It's about 2.3 metres long and weighs about 115 kilos. There are only about 400 of these in the world with 200 in zoos.
- **The South Chinese Tiger** is most in danger of dying out and there are perhaps only twenty to thirty of them in the wild and a few more (forty-seven) in Chinese zoos. They live in central and eastern China and weigh about 150 kilos.


